

James Sutton, 44, Oak Chase Blvd. Lenoir City, was charged with DUI, Poss. Of Drug Para., Contraband in Penal Institution, Violation of Implied Consent, Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic, Man/Sell/Sel/Resale Sch. I. and Simple Possession.

Deputy Rogers LCSO, observed a red SUV without rear taillights failing to maintain its lane and speeding on Hwy 70 near the Hwy 11 intersection. While attempting to initiate a traffic stop Deputy determined the vehicle was traveling at 90 mph in a 45 mph zone. After initiating his emergency lights near Wilkerson Ln, the vehicle continued approximately a

mile to Oak Chase Blvd before stopping. Upon contact with the driver, Mr. James Sutton Jr., Deputy observed him have a sweaty flushed complexion and pinpoint pupils. Deputy also observed a pipe used to smoke illegal substances in plain view in the passenger seat. Mr. Sutton performed very poorly during SFST/ARIDE testing and even showed clues of being heavily impaired, see case notes. Compiling the totality of the circumstances Deputy took Mr. Sutton into custody for DUI and Driving on a Suspended License. After a probable cause search of the vehicle, the marijuana pipe was recovered as well as 3 grams of marijuana. Deputy supplied and read TN Im-

plied Consent to Mr. Sutton and he did refuse a blood sample. Once at the jail C.O Longmire, recovered 1.5 grams of a light gray powder and 0.5 grams of a dark gray substance from Mr. Sutton's person. Mr. Sutton identified the substances as Heroin. Mr. Sutton was also charged with Contraband, Manufacture of Schedule Deputy and cited with Violation of Implied Consent, Paraphernalia, and Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic. Said did occur in Loudon County, TN.

Authorities allege that on the afternoon of May 29, 2006, Juarez-Corro entered South Shore Park on the banks of Lake Michigan, where hundreds of people were gathered for a Memorial Day picnic, including many families with children. Juarez-Corro approached a friend of his estranged wife's and began a conversation. Juarez-Corro and his wife were reported to be in the final stages of their divorce. The couple share a daughter, who was 3 years old at the time of the shooting.

"They were reportedly going through a difficult time in sharing visitation with their daughter," said Special Agent Steve Whitecotton, who is investigating this case out of the FBI's Milwaukee

Field Office

Shortly after entering the park, Juarez-Corro reportedly pulled out a gun and began firing. Two people were killed. Juarez-Corro's

wife suffered two gunshot wounds in the chest but survived. Two others were also injured, one of them gravely.

The fact that this individual would be so reckless in an area where families were gathered to celebrate—and in front of his 3-year-old daughter—is just utterly unacceptable," said Whitecotton. "He needs to be held accountable and brought to justice."

Juarez-Corro is now 47 vears old. He is believed to weigh between 180 and 200 pounds and has brown eyes and dark hair, which may be graying. He usually wears a mustache and sometimes a beard. He is between 65 and 67 inches tall.

Andrew Tamborino, 42, Dundee Road Knoxville, was charged with DUI, Driving on Roadway Laned For Traffic, and Lights Required on Motor Vehicle.

Chance Gray Deputy LCSO, observed a white Chevy Silverado traveling on Highway 444 near Coyatee Drive with a busted tail light emitting a glowing white light from the rear. While behind the vehicle Deputy also observed the vehicle cross the fog line and the center line multiple times.
