Local Providers Agree To Settle Allegations Of Improper Billing For Electro-Acupuncture Devices

The United States Attorney's Office announced today that Align Health and Holistic Medical Center, Inc. and Align Health Management, Inc., (collectively "Align"), Eric Anderson, P.A. d/b/a Anderson Chiropractic Clinic ("Anderson Chiropractic"), their

owners and a former employee have agreed to pay \$163,400 to resolve allegations that they knowingly and improperly billed Medicare for electro-acupuncture using peri-auricular stimulation devices in violation of the False Claims Act ("FCA"). Align and Anderson

Chiropractic are outpatient clinics located in Maryville, Tennessee that offer medical and chiropractic services for the treatment of pain. According to the contentions of the United States contained in the settlement agreement, between September 2016 and see Settled pg. 4

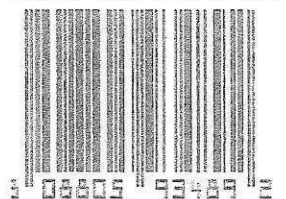

Brittani Fields, 29, Dodge Drive Knoxville, was charged with DUI, Traffic Control Service, Child Abuse or Neglect/Endangerment x2, and Violation of Implied Consent.

Sgt. M. Fagiana LCSO, observed a vehicle at the intersection of Hwy 70 and Hwy 11 sitting stationary while the light was green. The vehicle sat for several seconds at the intersection while the light was green. The vehicle then proceeded forward and came to a stop in the middle of the intersection and sat for several more seconds. The vehicle then continued on and almost struck a traffic barrier on Kingston Pike at Watt Road. Upon traffic stop, Cpl. Z. Frye and Sgt. Fagiana made contact with the driver, Brittani Fields. Fields appeared very lethargic, spoke with a slurred speech and had trouble staying awake while speaking. Sgt. Fagiana asked Fields to step out of the vehicle and she was very unsteady

on her feet. Fields stated she was driving home to Rogersville, TN but was unsure of exactly where she currently was. Fields stated she was prescribed Gabopentin and used it at approximately 4pm on the previous day. She also stated she was prescribed Xanax and last used it approximately 3hrs prior to this stop. Fields stated she had recently smoked marijuana as well. Fields consented to S.F.S.T and performed poorly on all tests. Based on the totality of the circumstances she was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence and cited for Traffic Control Device. Fields was read the TN Implied Consent Advisement and did not consent to provide a sample. In the car with Fields was two small male children ages 7 and 4. Fields was charged with two counts of Child Endangerment. Both children were transported to the Loudon County Justice Center and turned over to their Grandmother. This all occurred in Loudon County,

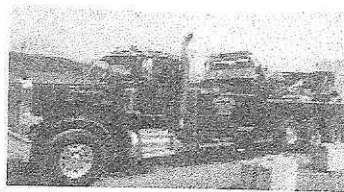

Nathan Armstrong, 32, Lakeview Drive Kingston, was charged with Simple Possession, and Theft of Property.

Officer R. Miller LCPD, observed a gold in color Chrysler 300 traveling south bound on Highway 321 in Lenoir City, TN. While observing the vehicle Officer noticed that the window tint on the vehicle was dark to the point that you could not see through the windows (24%). Officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of White Wing Road in Lenoir City. Upon traffic stop Officer made contact with a, Nathan Armstrong, of Kingston, TN and a, female, of Madisonville, TN.

During the traffic stop Officer conducted a warrant check on both subjects where

dispatch advised and confirmed that ARMSTRONG had a active warrant out of the city of Lenoir City for Theft Under \$1000.00 and a felony Violation of Probation out of Roane County, TN.

March 2019 Align and Anderson Chiropractic routinely presented, or caused to be presented, to Medicare false claims for payment for the placement of electro-acupuncture devices on patients. The placement of these devices was improperly billed under code L8679, which resulted in the clinics receiving payments from Medicare to which they were not entitled.

L8679 is a billing code for "implantable neurostimulator, pulse generator" devices that are surgically implanted into the central nervous system or targeted peripheral nerves through procedures that are typically performed by a surgeon in an operating room. However, the United States contends that Align and Anderson Chiropractic falsely billed Medicare under L8679 for electro-acupunc-

ture devices they knew were not surgically implanted into their patients and for procedures that did not involve anesthesia or take place in an operating room. The underlying services for which Align and Anderson Chiropractic submitted the L8679 claims involved application of a device used for electro-acupuncture. Common brand names for this device include P-Stim, Stivax, NeuroStim, ANSiStim, E-Pulse, and NSS-2 Bridge. The electro-acupuncture devices were applied by inserting needles into patients' ears and by taping the devices behind their ears with an adhesive. Medicare does not reimburse for electro-acupuncture devices billed as neurostimulators and did not reimburse for acupuncture at all during the period of the covered conduct.

In addition to paying the civil settlement, which was based on the parties' ability to pay, Align, Anderson Chiropractic, and their owners have agreed to enter into an Integrity Agreement ("IA") with the Office of Inspector General of the Department of Health and Human Services ("OIG-HHS"). The IA requires, among other things, that Align, Anderson Chiropractic, and their owners implement specific measures intended to prevent future health care fraud and to address evolving compliance risks. These measures include training for staff on applicable health care fraud laws and submitting to a claims review conducted by an Independent Review Organization to ensure compliance with Medicare billing requirements.

This investigation result-

ed from a coordinated effort between the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Tennessee, OIG-HHS, and the Southeastern Unified Program Integrity Contractor ("UPIC").

Assistant U.S. Attorney Joseph C. Rodriguez represented the United States.

The claims settled by this agreement are allegations only, and there has been no determination of liability.

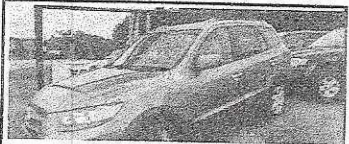

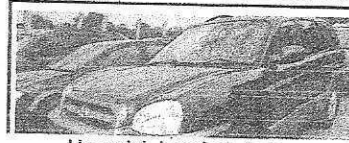

Kaitlyn Galyon, 24, Par-due Lane Lenoir City, was charged with Aggravated Arson.

Officer Samuels, was dispatched to Kelly Lane Apartment in reference to a 23 year old female, Kaitlyn Galyon, who locked herself in her bedroom and made suicidal threats. Upon arrival, Officer Miller and Samuels spoke with the complainant, who states that her daughter suffers from multiple mental disorders and made statements of harming herself this evening.

Officer Miller and Samuels walked upstairs to make contact with Kaitlyn. Once upstairs she opened the door, saw officers, shut the door and locked it. Officer then twisted the door knob to gain entry into the room. Officer gained entry and she pushed the door shut, Officer opened the door again at which time she poured some liquid, believed to be fingernail polish remover, on the carpet and clothes and set it on fire. 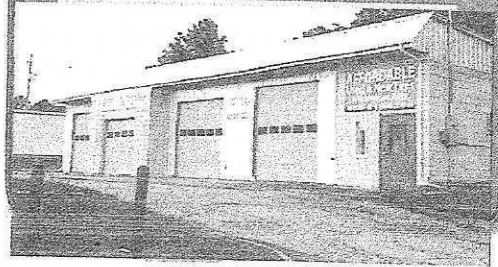

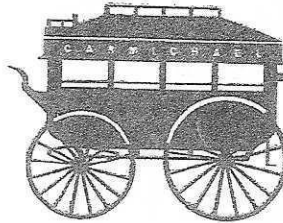
Obituaries
