Local Woman Charged with Credit Card Fraud and Theft

Former Tipton County Sheriff's Deputy Indicted on Three Counts



An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has resulted in the indictment of Daniel Jacobs, a former deputy for the Tipton County Sheriff's Office (TCSO), along with his acquaintance, Jacob Gardner.

The investigation began after sheriff's office officials reported a questionable transaction related to the sale of a 2010 Lincoln MKZ vehicle on the GovDeals.com website. The sheriff's

office uses this site to sell seized assets that have been awarded to the TCSO as well as surplus or obsolete TCSO assets. Jacobs, who worked as the TCSO evidence custodian, had access to the sheriff's office GovDeals.com administrative account to post assets for sale online.

On June 10, 2021, Jacobs attempted to sell the Lincoln MKZ on GovDeals.com for his personal benefit. The vehicle was list-

ed by Jacobs at 1:20 a.m. and purchased approximately 38 seconds later by Jacob Gardner for \$500 using a "buy now" option. Gardner was later identified as a friend of Jacobs. Jacobs admitted to TCSO officials that he intentionally posted the vehicle for sale so that Gardner could buy it for Jacobs for his personal use.

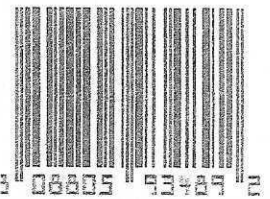

Jesse Morgan, McMahan Road Seymour, was charged with Violation of Order of Protection x2, and Domestic Assault x2.

CAITLIN TRANTANELLA, 31, Highland Ave Lenoir City, was charged with Aggravated Assault, and Interfere with Emergency Call 911.

Deputy S. Gaumer LCSO, was dispatched to a call for a domestic disturbance in-

volving a knife at Highland Avenue, Lenoir City, TN. When Deputy arrived on the scene, Officer Eldridge from Lenoir City Police Department was already there and had detained a female. Deputy later came to find out that the female is Caitlin Trantanella, a victim and offender. Upon first glance of the scene, Deputy found glass from the front door to be shattered and laying on the floor near the entry door. Ms. Trantanella had blood on

her left arm and kept saying that "the blood is his, not mine". Deputy also heard her say, "I stabbed him, I did it". At a closer examination, Deputy found no open wounds on her in the area where the blood was located. Inside, Deputy found a male, identified as Jesse Morgan, a victim, and offender, sitting on the toilet in the bathroom covered in blood. Deputy observed a laceration, approximately 2-3 inches in size, on

Mr. Morgan's right, upper shoulder. Deputy dressed the wound in gauze and wrapped it tightly to staunch the bleeding. While Deputy was dressing the wound, he kept repeating "she F&*** stabbed me, man" and "I'm so sick of the S\$#%". Shortly after the wrap was applied, medics transported him from the scene to Fort Loudon Medical Center for further medical treatment. Deputy

spoke with the daughter of Ms. Trantanella, the complainant/witness/victim, and learned what had occurred that evening. Witness said that Ms. Trantanella and Mr. Morgan had been consuming copious amounts of alcohol all evening which lead to a verbal altercation. During that time, Ms. Trantanella picked up a chair and threw it at the front door, causing

the glass to break.

At this point, witness said Mr. Morgan grabbed Ms. Trantanella and threw her into the bedroom door, breaking the door. From there, she said Ms. Trantanella grabbed a knife from the bedroom and stabbed Mr. Morgan with it. Witness attempted to call 911, but Ms. Trantanella took the phone from her hand, stabbed it, and threw the phone, effectively prevent-

ing witness from calling for help. Witness then ran to the next-door neighbor's house and called for help from their phone. Dispatch also notified Deputy that there is an active order of protection against Mr. Morgan with Ms. Trantanella and witness/victim as the protected parties. Ms. Trantanella is being charged with Interference with Emergency Calls and Aggravated Domestic Assault.

Mr. Morgan is being charged with Violation of Order of Protection and Domestic Assault. A DCS referral was made for victim by Sergeant C. Rogers. Referral #: 1405461183. Victim was left in the care of her grandfather. Deputy transported Ms. Trantanella from the scene to the Loudon County Jail without incident. Mr. Morgan was cleared and released

from Fort Loudon Medical Center and was transported to the Loudon County Jail without incident.

All occurred in Loudon County, TN.

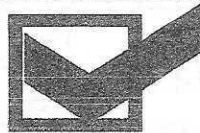
Tiffany Gamble, 41, price Road Lenoir City, was charged with Fraudulent use of Credit Card, and /theft of Property.

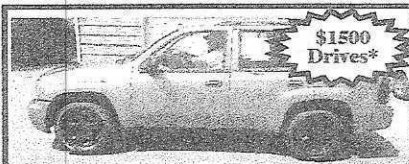

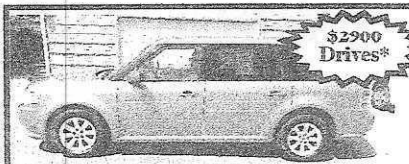

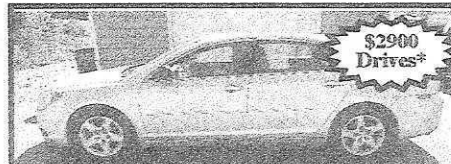

Meth

Donna Russell, 53, Meadow Road Greenback, was charged with Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. Of Meth, Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, and Display of Registration Plate.

Officer Parmer LCPD, observed a red Dodge Charger with an un-readable TN temporary tag, with the expiration date being blocked by the rear wing of the vehicle and no registration lights on the vehicle.

Officer initiated a stop on the vehicle at the corner of West Broadway and Grand Street. Officer made contact

with the driver who was identified as 53 year old Donna Russell. Officer ran Ms. Russell's ID through central dispatch to which it came back suspended.

Officer requested consent to search Ms. Russell's vehicle based on her nervous behavior to which she granted consent. Upon searching the vehicle, Officer Law located a small container inside of Ms. Russell's purse which was located on the passenger seat. Inside of the container was 1.31 grams of a white, crystal-like substance which appeared to be Methamphetamine.

Ms. Russell was then placed under arrest and transported to Loudon County Jail without incident. The above did occur in Lenoir City, Loudon County, Tennessee.

Indicted

Recovery of the unauthorized transaction, TCSO officials immediately cancelled the sale, and the \$500 payment was credited back to Gardner. On October 14, 2021, the vehicle was properly sold on GovDeals.com for \$2,853.83.

Based upon this investigation, in July 2022, the Tipton County Grand Jury indicted Daniel Jacobs for one count of official misconduct, one count of attempted theft of property over \$2,500, and one count of computer crimes over \$2,500. Jacob Gardner was also indicted for one count of attempted theft

of property over \$2,500.

"We recommend the sheriff's office establish a written policy for how the sale of assets should be handled through online platforms," said Comptroller Jason Mumpower. "This policy will provide guidance to employees and decrease the risk of improper activity. I'm pleased to note that TCSO officials indicate they will address this issue."
