

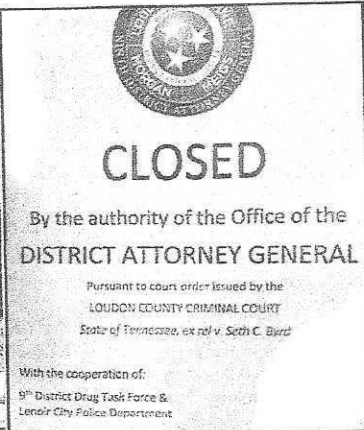

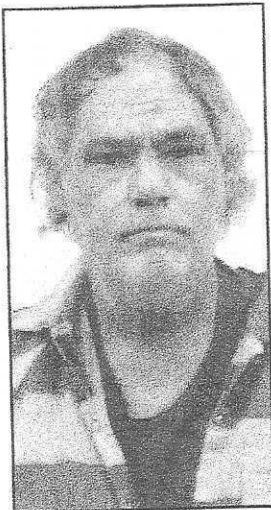

## Global measles threat continues to grow as another year passes with millions of children unvaccinated

Following years of declines in measles vaccination coverage, measles cases in 2022 have increased by 18%, and deaths have increased by 43% globally (compared to 2021). This takes the estimated number of measles cases to 9 million and deaths to 136,000 – mostly among children – according to a new report from the World Health Organization

(WHO) and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Measles continues to pose a relentlessly increasing threat to children. In 2022, 37 countries experienced large or disruptive outbreaks compared with 22 countries in 2021. Of the countries experiencing outbreaks, 28 were in the WHO Region for Africa, six in the Eastern Mediterra-

nean, two in Southeast Asia, and one in the European Region.

"The increase in measles outbreaks and deaths is staggering, but unfortunately, not unexpected given the declining vaccination rates we've seen in the past few years," said John Vertefeuille, director of CDC's Global Immunization

### Jenkins

The Ninth Judicial Drug Task Force and The Lenoir City Police Department boarded up a "drug house" Thursday afternoon after it was deemed a nuisance.

District Attorney General Russell Johnson's office ADA Jason Culver submitted a nuisance petition for the home at 161 Finley Dr. that was signed by Judge Wicks Thursday morning.

"The reason we're doing this is because we've had two fatal overdoses over the last few months as well as numerous calls for service to the area," Johnson said.

Past calls for to the home ranged from reports of domestic assault, to suspicious persons and stolen vehicles. Lenoir City Police Chief Don White said officers

have responded to the home at least ten times over the last two years. General Johnson pointed at that 8 specific calls of service were documented in the petition.

"Suspicious people being out at one or two o'clock in the morning, disturbing the peace with either music or fighting, it was just all across the board, not what you would normally expect in a nice quiet neighborhood," White said.

Johnson said the overdose deaths at the home are part of a bigger problem in Loudon County.

"Last year we had 16 through the entire year in 2022, right now we're up to 31 in Loudon County," he said. "So we've already approached close to twice of what we had last year with a month and a half left to go."

Johnson also stated most of those overdose deaths can be attributed to fentanyl which is coming from China directly through Mexico.

The property owner, Seth Byrd, is currently in jail for violation of probation at the Loudon County Jail.

Johnson said they've done

around 10 of these operations over the last few years, with several being in Lenoir City.

Mayor Tony Aikens stated "this is a great example of why it's vital to have cooperation with neighbors and police to help build these cases that protect the citizens of Lenoir City."

David Abney, 58, Virtue Road Lenoir City, was charged with Man/Sell/Del/Resale Sch. II, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Jimmy Rolon, 42, Oak Wood Drive Lenoir City, was charged with Mfg/Sell/Poss. of Controlled Substance.

Investigator Green LCSO, observed a Black Chevy Tahoe hauling a trailer traveling on Hotchkiss Valley Road W. Inv. Green observed this vehicle drift and continue traveling into the opposite lane of travel multiple times. Inv. Green paced this vehicle traveling 40mph in a 35mph zone. Inv. Green conducted a traffic stop at Sugarlimb Road. This vehicle continued rolling at a slow speed until reaching the Southbound on Ramp. As Inv. Division. "Measles cases anywhere pose a risk to all countries and communities where people are under-vaccinated. Urgent, targeted efforts are critical to prevent measles disease and deaths."

Measles is preventable with two doses of measles vaccine. While a modest increase in global vaccination coverage occurred in 2022 from 2021, there were still 33 million children who missed a measles vaccine dose: nearly 22 million missed their first dose and an additional 11 million missed their second dose. The global vaccine coverage rate of the first dose, at 83%, and second dose, at 74%, were still well under the 95% coverage with the two doses necessary to protect communities from outbreaks.

Low-income countries, where the risk of death from measles is highest, continue

to have the lowest vaccination rates at only 66%; a rate that shows no recovery at all from the backsliding during the pandemic. Of the 22 million children who missed their first measles vaccine dose in 2022, over half live in just 10 countries: Angola, Brazil, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ethiopia, India, Indonesia, Madagascar, Nigeria, Pakistan, and Philippines

"The lack of recovery in measles vaccine coverage in low-income countries following the pandemic is an alarm bell for action. Measles is called the inequity virus for good reason. It is the disease that will find and attack those who aren't protected," said Kate O'Brien, WHO Director for Immunization, Vaccine and Biologicals. "Children everywhere have the right to be protected by the lifesaving measles vaccine, no matter where

they live."

CDC and WHO urge countries to find and vaccinate all children against measles and other vaccine-preventable diseases and encourage global stakeholders to aid countries to vaccinate their most vulnerable communities. In addition, to help prevent outbreaks, all global health partners at the global, regional, national, and local levels must invest in robust surveillance systems and outbreak response capacity to rapidly detect and respond to outbreaks.

CDC and WHO are founding members of the Measles & Rubella Partnership (M&RP), a global initiative to stop measles and rubella. Under the umbrella of Immunization Agenda 2030 and guided by the Measles and Rubella Strategic Framework 2030, M&RP's mission includes addressing the decline in national vac-

cination coverage, hastening COVID-19 pandemic recovery and accelerating progress towards creating a world free of measles and rubella. The partnership also includes American Red Cross, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, United Nations Foundation, and UNICEF.

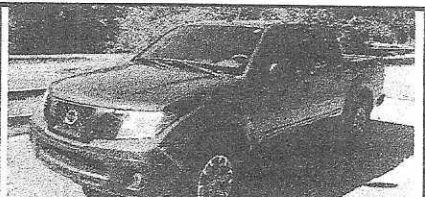

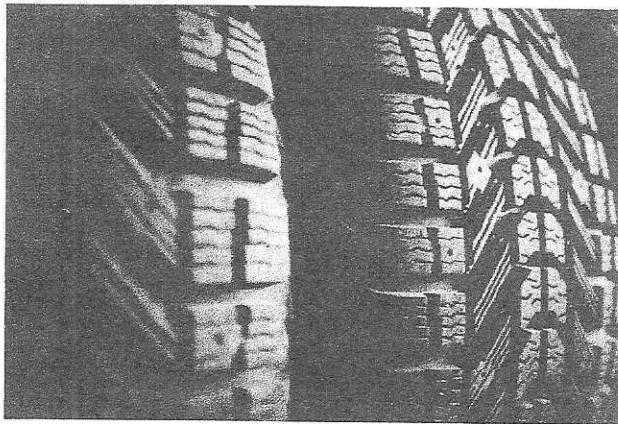
