

Erin Emerson, 52. Roland Link Boulevard Oak Ridge, was charged with DUI, Simple Possession, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Officers with the Lenoir City Police Department received a call of a reckless driver in the area of Highway 70 and Avalon. The complaint stated a dark colored Mercedes was all over the road and did not have a tag on the vehicle. Officer Skyler McGinnis observed the vehicle in the area of Highway 70 and Highway 321, upon observing the vehicle, he observed the vehicle swaying back and forth

285 Highway 70 West. Officer Law, was on scene and identified the female to be Erin Emerson, upon speaking to Ms. Emerson she was having difficulty pay attention. While furthering his investigation, Ms. Emerson stated he had a medical disorder that prevented her from sitting still.

While conducting my investigation Ms. Emerson stated she had taken Ritalin and Zofran prior to our encounter through her nasal cavity. Officer located a small circler container with a crushed up grey pill, and a half-cut straw with the same matching residue inside.



Brian Brewster, 51, Homeless Loudon, was charged with Mfg/Del/Sale or Poss. of Meth, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Officer R. Miller, with the Lenoir City Police Depart-ment, responded to Highway 321 (Holiday Inn Express) located in Lenoir City, TN in regards to a male subject who was possibly unconscious and slumped over in the driver's seat of a parked vehicle. Officer Miller was able to quickly locate the vehicle and the male subject. As Officer Mill-er approached the vehicle, he could see that the male subject in the driver's seat was leaned over and petting his dog who was in the front passenger's seat of the vehicle. Officer also noticed a hypodermic needle laying on the sunroof of the vehicle. Officer Miller made contact with the male subject who was identified as Brain Brewster.

asked Officer Miller BREWSTER about the hypodermic needle at which time he stated he didn't know it was there. Officer then conducted a search of BREWSTERS pocket at which time he located a small bag containing a crystal-like substance believed to be methamphetamine in BREWSTERS right pocket. BREWSTER was placed under arrest. While under arrest BREWSTER stated that he was on probation out of Monroe County, TN for possession of methamphetamine. During the investigation, central dispatch advised that BREWSTER had two warrants out of Monroe County, TN one being for violation of probation and the other being for failure to appear. The approximate weight of the crystal-like substance along with the bag was (0.38 grams). BREWSTER was transported to the Loudon County Jail.



on their person when they are booked, the funds are also placed in their commissary account, utilizing the kiosk.

Investigators compared the cash collections in the kiosks to the department's cash deposits and discovered that Ceaser failed to deposit \$35,158.88 of inmate funds into the inmates' commissary bank account.

Ceaser concealed her misappropriation by falsifying general ledger journal entries and deposit slips.

Based upon this investigation, in November 2023, Neina Ceaser was indicted by the Lake County Grand Jury for one count of theft of property over \$10,000, one count of destruction of and tampering with governmental records, and one count of official misconduct.

"Sheriff's department officials must provide adequate oversight and implement effective internal controls over cash collected in the kiosks," said Comptroller Mumpower. "One person should not be responsible for collecting the cash, counting it, depositing it, and posting the journal entries. I'm pleased to note the department is already taking steps to address this issue."

Deputy Stanley LCSO, responded to Watkins Road in regards to a Domestic. While enroute, the deputy was informed that one of the parties involved (Joseph Goins) had an active warrant out of

Loudon County. Upon arrival, Deputy Stanley made contact with the victim at the door. She advised her boy-friend Joseph Goins was inside the house, and she gave permission for deputies to enter the residence. Deputy did observe bruising along the left side of Russell's face. where she stated was sustained during the altercation.

Goins denied the altercation turning physical. Deputy also spoke with the victims mother, who was the caller, and she advised she had heard the altercation when the victim called her.

Due to observations on scene Deputy informed Joseph Goins he was also charged with Domestic Assault, and transported him to the Loudon County Jail without incident. All occurred in Loudon County.


