

There are also sealed indictment which are not contained on the report. Those indictments are not made public until the suspect has been taken into custody and charged with the indictment.

Joseph Sales, 34, Popular Springs Road Loudon, was charged with Theft of Property x2, Burglary, and Violation of Probation.

Officers with Loudon Police Dept. were notified by the Loudon County Sheriffs office that a Brooklyn Wood had called a Joseph Sales, the

deputies then stated that they heard through the phone call that he was hiding at the house that the officers were at earlier looking for him for warrants that detective Jenkins had wrote. Officer Clemmer and SGT M. Newman along with Officers Everett and Ingram arrived back at the residence on Commerce Street and made contact with the home-

owner and informed her of the reason we were back and she gave us permission to search the residence. SGT. M. Newman and Clemmer located the male lying under the bed in the kids room and gave the male subject commands to come out.

We then placed Joseph Sales into custody. Joseph Sales was placed under arrest for two counts of theft of property and burglary and he also had a hard copy in hand warrant from Knox County. The above actions did occur in the city of Loudon





Chadwick Goins, 28, 640 road Oklahoma, was charged with DUI, Violation of Implied Consent, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Deputy Brockwell LCSO, stopped a vehicle for a welfare check based on the vehicle driving on a flat tire. Prior to the stop, deputy was flagged down by 2 unknown citizens advising the offender was possibly impaired. Deputy ran the vehicle tag, and it came back not on file. Upon speaking to the driver (Chadwick David Goins), he had rapid slurred speech, dilated pupils, and was sweating with it being 34 degrees outside. Deputy asked the driver if he had used any narcotics recently, and he stated that he did not. Based on observations of the driver Deputy asked the driver if he would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs) to make sure he was capable of driving. When the driver exited the vehicle, deputy observed a small white pill and a snorting straw in the center console of the vehicle. Based on the totality of the circumstances and his poor SFST performance

indicated that he was under the influence and placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence. He was read the implied consent advisement form and refused to provide a sample. Deputy asked Goins if he had anything illegal on him, and he said he did not. After seeing the white pill and the snorting straw that gave him probable cause to search the vehicle and found 3 snorting straws and 7 800 milligrams ibuprofens. Deputy transported him to the Loudon County Detention Facility. They arrived inside the sallyport and Deputy Gant and Brockwell asked Goins if he had anything illegal on him and he stated no. Upon entering the change-out room Goins did admit to having something inside of his pants. Deputy Gaut retrieved the item which was a glass meth

During this time Goins stated, under his own free will, that he smoked meth prior to us stopping him. The white pills were seized to be destroyed and the snort straws and meth pipe were bagged and placed into evidence. This did happen in Loudon County, TN without further incident.
