of an alcoholic beverage coming from Cansler as he spoke and she observed Cansler to have blood shot and glossy eyes. Cpl. Wallen asked Cansler to exit his vehicle and walk back to her patrol unit to further her investigation and Cansler was unsteady on his feet as he walked. When asked, Cansler admitted that he was traveling home from an establishment in Knoxville where he had just consumed "6 beers and 2 shots." Cansler agreed to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs), and he performed poorly.

Based on Cpl. Wallen observation of the vehicle in motion, Cansler's physical state, Cansler's admission to consuming alcohol,

and Cansler's performance Capias. on the SFSTs, Cpl. Wallen determined that Cansler was under the influence of an intoxicant that impaired his ability to safely operate a motor vehicle on a public roadway. Cansler was taken into custody and read the Implied Consent Advisement. Cansler refused to provide a blood sample for testing.

threw absorbent pads into the spilled mixture and then used a portable pump to pump the petroleum-contaminated mixture over a retaining wall at DES. The oily mixture flowed over a neighboring property and into a culvert leading to the Holston River.

"Domermuth Environmental Services and Christopher Domermuth were supposed to be cleaning up contaminated water and soil to protect the environment, but instead caused the discharge of pollutants. These felony guilty pleas demonstrate our commitment to enforcing the Clean Water Act," said






