



Jorge Luis Lopez, 25, Liberty Street Knoxville, was charged with, DUI, Violation of Implied Consent, No Driving License, and Failure to Show Proof of Insurance.

Deputy Lewis LCSO, along with Deputy Turpin observed a silver Nissan Sentra Texas tag stop in the middle of the road on Buttermilk Rd the deputies then turned around to investigate what the issue was. incident. While doing inventory of the vehicle the deputy discovered 3 empty beer cans and 1 freshly opened glass bottle of Smirnoff.


