




6. Moreover, should anyone else in the household develop symptoms within the next ten days, the 14-day quarantine period will start again.
7. That accordingly, Mrs. Myers would move this Honorable Court for a continuance of the sentencing hearing in this matter.
8. That based upon the prospective length of quarantine and the possibility of extension should other household members test positive, Mrs. Myers would request a setting in January to ensure no further delay.

WHEREFORE, the Accused, Christina Erin Myers, respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an Order continuing the sentencing hearing in this case.
